Muskegon Public Schools will continue to operate under universal masking. MPS continues to urge students and staff, if you do not feel well do not come to school. We are aligning our isolation/quarantine plan with the recommendations from Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) and the Center for Disease Controls (CDC) new K-12 school recommended COVID guidelines. Day "0" is the day of last close contact or the date of positive test.

## If the staff/student tests positive:

## Positive test

- Home Isolation days 0-5
- Return to school masked 6-10\*

You must be symptom free to return to school.

## If the staff/student are Close Contact/Exposed<sup>+</sup> to positive person:

Up to date Vaccines or Covid within last 90 days

- No need to quarantine unless symptomatic
- No symptoms, monitor and masked days 0-10

Not Vaccinated

- Home quarantine for days 0-5, test, masked return days 6-10\*
- Home quarantine day 0-10 if unable/unwilling to mask

You must be symptom free to return to school.

+ Close contact includes a positive case in the household or contact within 6' without mask

<sup>\*</sup> Masking is required 100% of the time indoors. Eating/drinking must be done separately at a safe distance. Any activity requiring removal of a mask (Band, PE, mask breaks, etc.) must not be done until after this time period.
